The criteria for the OSPAN PeriAnesthesia Excellence in Clinical Practice Award is as follows:

1. This award is designed to recognize a PeriAnesthesia Nurse in Oklahoma who has:
 - a. Demonstrated excellence in the practice, management, or teaching of PeriAnesthesia Nursing
 - b. Promotes the high standards of PeriAnesthesia Nursing
2. **Mandatory Criteria for Nomination:**
 - a. RN directly involved in PeriAnesthesia Clinical Nursing for a minimum of two years
 - b. Fill out the form to show how you or your nominee accomplished excellence in their clinical practice (up to 10 points for each question)
 - c. Current ASPAN/OSPAN member
 - d. Is recognized by peers and or management as an expert and a leader which can be validated by submitting two letters of reference
3. **Additional credit as follows:**
 - a. CPAN certified (3 points)
 - b. CAPA certified (3 points)
 - c. Current ACLS (1 point)
 - d. ACLS instructor (2 points)
 - e. Current PALS (1 point)
 - f. PALS instructor (2 points)
 - g. Actively participates in evidence based practice activity in a PeriAnesthesia arena (1 point)
 - h. Functions as preceptor to at least one new staff member in a PeriAnesthesia area (1 point)
 - i. Presented lecture(s) on topics specific to PeriAnesthesia (1 point per lecture)
 - j. Promotes specialty of PeriAnesthesia nursing by involvement in community services, projects, health fairs, etc. in the past year (1 point per project)
 - k. Recipient of awards related to PeriAnesthesia nursing (1 point per award)
